Job Connect and Pathways to Employment for Newcomers

- Both programs assist internationally trained personnel from a broad range of sectors such as IT, Finance, Accounting, Human Resources, Sales and Marketing, Engineering, etc.

The goal of the MicroSkills program is to find suitable applicants for your employment needs and to save you time and money with advertising and screening costs. There are not any fees for this service. Also, some programs offer a financial incentive.

Additionally, MicroSkills provides a Work Placement Program (similar to a co-op program) for their graduates and some clients. Program graduates are available for 6 weeks work placement.
