Introduction to Hydronic Heating Installations

This course has been developed by the Northern Alberta Institute of Technology specifically for the Canadian Hydronics Council. It is designed to assist a hydronic heating installer to interpret job specific designs and incorporate best piping practices and control application. You will examine a hydronic design for a single family home, and utilizing the design documents, blueprints, and supporting materials, explore the hows and whys of the design for this dwelling based on three different mixing and piping scenarios.

This is an entry level course and the starting point for those who are interested in the professional installation of hydronic heating systems. Participants will learn basic knowledge of how the design relates to the installation and how to avoid the pitfalls that cause the installation to fail.

What will you learn?

Upon completion of this course you will be able to:

- Introduce basic concepts of heat loss
- Understand the characteristics of various types of boilers
- Correctly interpret manufacturers' instructions and apply the information
- Identify and arrange required boiler trim
- Recognize various piping systems and their applications
- Identify basic types of heat emission systems

Who should attend?

This is recommended for anyone who wants to learn the latest basics in hydronic installation practices: Installers, contractors, designers, wholesalers, manufacturers and agents.
