Over 250 delegates, companions and guests from across Canada and the U.S.A. will be in Newfoundland attending CIPH's 78th Annual Business Conference at the Sheraton Hotel Newfoundland from June 27-30, 2010. Many of these members will gather at the build site on Charter Avenue in the Quidi Vidi Lake neighbourhood for the Official Sod Turning Ceremony at 2:30 pm. Guests will have the opportunity to meet the partner family, Angela Marsh and her two children aged 5 and 3.
